Alpha Children Parent Education Workshop

Alpha children are often described as bossy, prescriptive and controlling, demanding, competitive and can be labelled as a bully. Alpha children are not only more challenging to parent, but also predisposed to a number of problems including anxiety, aggression, oppositionality and eating problems. The root of the problem - the alpha dynamic - is one of the least known and yet most impactful factors in a relationship. While the focus of the workshop is on children, the revelations and challenges are for us as adults.

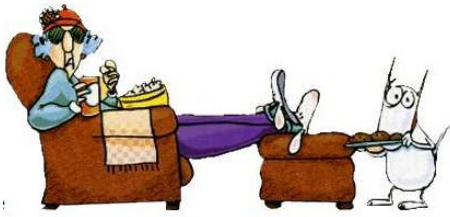


DECLARATION

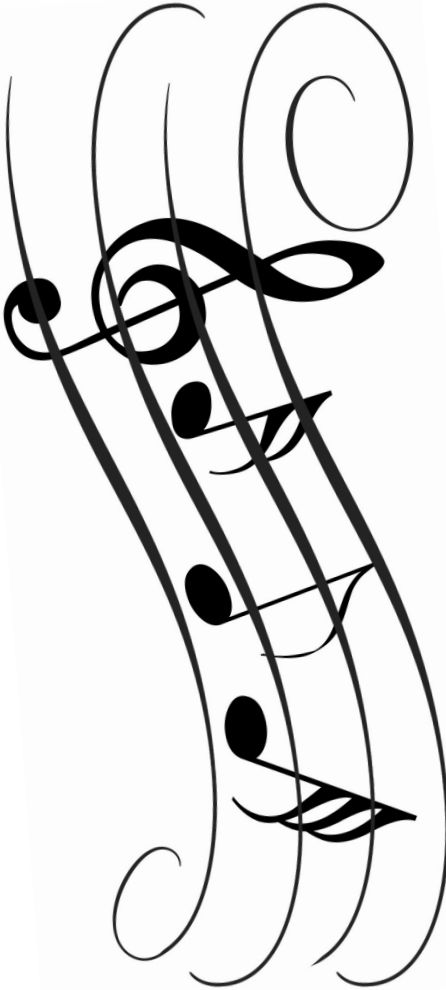

Leduc County Community Services

Dean Ohnysty, Sara Russell & Carol Tabone made a presentation to Council from Leduc County Family & Community Services.

Leduc & District Food Bank

The Village of Warburg will contribute \$1,000.00 to the Leduc & District Food Bank for the 2021 budget year.

International Day of Older Persons

Council declared October 1, 2020 as International Day of Older Persons in the Village of Warburg.

Community Standards Bylaw #159/18—Section 211

Section 211 of the Community Standards Bylaw #159/18 will be amended to allow for two (2) recreational Vehicles and that the bylaw include the addition of Section 211. 3. Owner must reside in residence of same property.

Major Home Business Inclusion

Section 42.3.1 of the Land Use Bylaw will be amended to read “The home business shall be operated by the permanent resident(s) of the principal dwelling, and shall employ no more than 2 non-resident employees”

Retirement Open House for Nancy Laing—September 30, 2020

A retirement video will be prepared for Ms. Laing and any member of Council or administration may attend.

LRHF Municipal conversation—October 7, 2020

Administration will prepare a brief presentation on what Leduc Region Municipalities are planning, both immediate and long term, for non-market and market affordable housing in their communities. Seniors Van

Council approved the purchase of the ARBOC Spirit of Freedom Low Floor 16+2 seat van from Crestline in the amount of \$149,821 in partnership with Leduc Foundation (Cloverleaf Manor Residents Club) with the Village's amount being approximately \$45,000.

Hydrant at 47th Street and 55th Avenue

The Village of Warburg will install a fire hydrant on 47th Street located on the North side of 55th Avenue.
